

Cabochon

Cabochon means a stone cut in a convex shape not faceted like a diamond. The finial on lids is in a convex shape or form.

Cabochon was Heisey's last full pressed line before the company went out of business. It was produced during the last seven years of the company.

This pattern continued the modernistic trend of the 50's. Cabochon was designed by Horace King. Rod Irwin wanted a casual living pattern.

Initially, this design was to have no decorations applied, but in 1952, someone put the Plantation Ivy on the covered candy.

Lily etching is known on some goblets, but it was not a production decoration. (p. 334 Bredehoft book)
